GODKNOWS when to send you exactly what you need.

I thought that my most unusual Easter was the time as a kid when I got not only a candy filled Easter Basket from the Easter Bunny, but I also received a little live chick. I don't remember what I named the little chicken, but I do remember trying to care for the little guy as best that I could for a few days after Easter. It was at the end of Easter Week that my father announced to me that he had taken my little friend to a farm because that is where chickens really belong. He would have a good home there and lots of space to run and grow with other chickens. Only later in life did my father confess that unfortunately my little friend didn't survive confined to our little living room "chicken coup" which was simply a shoebox. My little chick had gone to the Big Farm in the sky. Who would want to live life in a shoebox anyway? We are soon to celebrate a most unusual Easter.

A most unusual Lent now culminates in a most unusual Holy Week and a most unusual Holy Week will culminate in a most unusual Easter. This year, however, will **not** be **the** most unusual Easter. The Original Easter was. It was on that day that a man having been put to death for alleging to have been the very Son of God rose from the dead proving it. There was never a day so unusual such that all of our Faith and all of our Hope born that day remain despite present events in our world being most unusual. At the moment, the corona virus continues to spread and we're told that we've not yet reached peak infection. We continue our social distancing and staying at home. Schools are closed indefinitely. Uncertainty and its accompanying fear are rampant. This virus is starting to hit home for many. It all seems to be so much headline news and internet chatter until someone that we know is infected. All of us are privileged to have had a birth mother. We wouldn't be here without her. In my life, I've been privileged to have a number of other mothers as well, "adopted moms" as I call them. Some I've known before I was a priest and some I've gotten to know since my ordination and because of it. It is one of these "moms" (one that has known me since I was a teenager) that has now been diagnosed with COVID-19. With the healthcare protocols now in place, I can't even go to see her. Neither can her own children. We're all hoping and praying for the best, but it's the uncertainty and fear that can overwhelm – if one lets it. I will not let it. This is because of that most unusual original Easter Day and the Faith and the Hope that emerged from the tomb along with a Risen Son of God. I've been blessed to have been able to anoint my "adopted" mom any number of times well before she wound up in the hospital and well before there was talk of any virus. "Mom" isn't expected to make it through this night. I pray for the best, though I know that the best is yet to come – for all of us. In this most unusual time of crisis, continue to have Faith and continue to have Hope. Continue to hold fast onto that which was given to us on that very first and most unusual Original Easter Day!

Our Lady of the Holy Cross! Pray for us!



In case your were wondering...Yes...our Food Pantry continues to provide food to our "Neighbors in Need" in our community.

For the safety of everyone, we are doing a drive-thru in the parking lot directly outside of our Community Center (in back of the school). Folks pull up with their cars, we take their names and then we put the food in their cars and they drive out the back gate. Just as all of you are doing, we are striving to be flexible during these dire times.

Do you or your company pay PA state taxes?

Do you or your company pay Pennsylvania state taxes? Why not donate them to Holy Cross School? The application process is easy and we can work hand-in-hand with you to complete it. At Holy Cross, 100% of your donation through EITC and OSTC is used for scholarships for students and tuition assistance for our families to afford a Catholic Education.

Individuals

Individuals can redirect up to 100% of their personal Pennsylvania state income tax bill to Holy Cross. Donors will receive a tax credit for 90% of the EITC or OSTC contribution, which reduces their state income taxes dollar-for-dollar. Further, many individuals will also be able to claim a charitable deduction on their federal tax return for the 10% not included in the tax credit.

Corporations

Corporations are also eligible to receive a 90% Pennsylvania tax credit if they are authorized to do business in Pennsylvania and are subject to one or more of the following taxes:

- Corporate Net Income Tax
- Insurance Premium Tax (excluding surplus lines, unauthorized, domestic/foreign

marine)

- Title Insurance & Trust Company Shares Tax
- Bank and Trust Company Shares Tax
- Capital Stock and Franchise Tax
- Mutual Thrift Tax
- Malt Beverage Tax
- Retaliatory Fees under section 212 of the Insurance Company Law of 1921
- Personal Income Tax of corporation shareholders or Partnership partners


