FROM THE PASTOR

We welcome back the students of Holy Cross School this week. Let's all pray that this is a great year of learning and faith formation for all of them.

I saw the following statistics the other day on a Catholic blog, and they're worth sharing.

U.S. Catholic Population, 2022

Catholic at some point in life: 87,783,408 Currently identify as Catholic: 73,224,400

Attending Mass Christmas/Easter or more 52,721,568

Registered with a Parish 41,957,581

Attending Mass at least once per month 32,950,980 Attending Mass at least once per week 17,573,856 "Very involved" in parish outside of Mass 8,944,068

What does this tell us? It's not a pretty picture.

- Of those who are baptized, 16.5% don't consider themselves Catholic anymore.
- Of those who say they are Catholic, 28% don't even come to Church on Christmas or Easter.
- Of those who say they are Catholic, 42% are not registered with a parish. Makes you wonder, are their kids baptized or in any kind of religious education? Are they supporting the work of the Church financially at all?
- Of those who say they are Catholic, 55% percent attend Mass less than once per month!
- Only 24% of those who say they are Catholic attend Mass weekly.

A few weeks ago, we heard the parable of the Good Samaritan. A man fell victim to thieves and robbers and was left for dead in the street. The Priest and Levite ignored him; the Samaritan made the man's problems his own and cared for him, transporting him with his own animal and using his own money and resources to provide medical care, food, and shelter.

The numbers above show that the Church is wounded, and her enemies are more than happy to leave her for dead. We can look at those numbers with indifference, or we can be like the Good Samaritan, jump in, and do something about it. My goal (and my job) as the pastor of this parish is to engage us as a parish to try and do something about it.

That is why we took the Disciple Maker Index in the Spring. We are now getting ready to start a three-year program called the Next Generation Parish, which will allow us to take a look at those results, assess our parish life, and discern ways to reinvigorate the faith of our parishioners. More information will be coming to us soon about this program. Please pray for its success. With God's help and our dedication, we can do great things, and we will!


