FROM THE PASTOR

Lent begins in a week and half with the celebration of Ash Wednesday. To help make your Lenten dining experience a little easier, the parish and school will be selling crab cakes and soup from Capt'n Chuckies this week. Information on how to order can be found on flyers in the vestibules and on our website. Orders must be turned in by 11:00 am on Monday, February 20. Orders will be available for pickup on Ash Wednesday from 3:00-7:00 pm. See the flyer for more information.

Here's an opportunity to consider for Lent and beyond. Archbishop Perez will be sending out a weekly challenge via text message to those who sign up. Each message will consist of a concrete action step you can do to help you deepen your friendship with Jesus or grow in your mission to help bring Jesus to others. If you wish to sign up, it's really easy. You can text GOFORTH to 84576. Or you can visit phillydisciples.org/goforth and provide your information that way. The program starts Ash Wednesday; messages will be sent weekly for a year. I hope you'll consider signing up!

Something else to consider for Lent: sign up for Formed, and make an effort to check out their content on a daily or weekly basis, especially as a family. There are videos, podcasts, children's programs, and more. And it's all FREE! (Well, free to you. As a parish we pay a subscription fee each year so can access the content at no cost.) Signing up for Formed is really easy: just go to formed.org, click "sign up as a parishioner," search for our ZIP code 19064, and pick Holy Cross. Once you're signed up, there's a ton of content available. Grandparents: there are lots of fun kids' programs with Catholic themes. If you're babysitting, instead of watching Paw Patrol or Peppa Pig for the 1 billionth time, check out the Brother Francis videos—there's even a kids' version of the Stations of the Cross, which would be great during Lent.

This weekend, a number of our second grade students in PREP and Holy Cross School celebrated the Sacrament of Penance for the first time. We can all be proud of them and grateful to their teachers for getting them ready for this important sacramental celebration. Please remember these students in your prayers as they get ready for First Communion in a couple months.

Next Sunday, we plan for the Springfield Ambulance Corps to be here at Holy Cross to give a brief tutorial after the Masses about compression-only CPR. It will be worth sticking around for a few minutes to learn a skill that could help save someone's life.
