

Lent begins this week with Ash Wednesday. We will have Masses at 8:30 am and 7:00 pm, at which ashes will be distributed. On Ash Wednesday, volunteers will be handing out cards as you leave the church with more information on the Forgiven program that our Adult Faith Formation team is presenting during Lent, along with the Confession schedule. The videos and discussion are pretty powerful, and I hope you will make the effort to participate. The program runs over three weeks, and there are different times and days available each week to hopefully accommodate your schedule.

Also as part of our Lenten devotions, we will have Stations of the Cross on Fridays, both at 2:00 pm and at 7:00 pm. Children from the school will be in attendance at the 2:00 time, and the reflections might be more geared toward their level, but all parishioners are welcome to join us.

We've been talking about it for a while, but now it's here. **The Disciple Maker Index goes live on Ash Wednesday.** A link to the survey can be found on our website, http://holycrosscatholics.org, and we will be sending more information to parishioners via e-mail as well. Please, please, please, take a few minutes to fill out this survey.

Still being new as the pastor here, the survey will be an invaluable opportunity to get a "state of the parish." Broad participation will help me, working with the staff and volunteer ministry leaders, to plan a vision and set goals for the years ahead. This is *your* parish, and we want (and need) *your* feedback and input to make sure we are serving you well. The survey runs for a few weeks, and I'm sure I'll be talking about it quite a bit in the next couple bulletins.

On Saturday, March 5, our choir will be traveling to the Cathedral to sing at their Saturday Evening Mass. Periodically, the Cathedral welcomes choirs from parishes around the Archdiocese to assist with the singing at one of their Masses, and I am proud that Holy Cross is going to be represented in that group. Let us all wish them well as they share their talents and edify the worship in the Mother Church of the Archdiocese.

Next Sunday, March 6, we will welcome Bishop Senior to Holy Cross Parish as he celebrates the Sacrament of Confirmation for 23 of our parish children at the 11:00 Mass. Please pray for those to be confirmed that the outpouring of grace in the Sacrament will help them to live as faith-filled disciples of Christ. Also, a heads-up: we will have several pews reserved for the candidates, their sponsors, and their families, so you might not be able to sit in your "favorite" pew. Please be on the lookout for reserved signs.

## Fast and Abstinence and Other Acts of Penance for Lent 2022

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022, on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday (with the exception of Friday, March 25, The Solemnity of St. of the Annunciation of the Lord). Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.

**For Kids**: This is under the "<u>Kids</u>" banner; "Lent with Brother Francis."

**For Teens**: the "<u>Real + True</u>" banner; "Real + True (English)". Continue this series with Unit 2.

For Families: "The Search" banner; continue this series. Also, in conjunction with our in-person Parish Bible Study, "The Sacraments" banner has "Forgiven: the Transforming Power of Confession." And "Living Lent as a Family" is a 4-part series; it's under the "FORMED Now" banner, however the easiest way to find it is to do a search for "Living Lent as a Family" and it will pop right up.

<u>"Movie Night"</u> banner: "Don Bosco: The True Story of the Apostle of Youth." Also, continue any of "The Bible Collection" series.
