

A couple weeks ago, we celebrated four funeral Masses in one week here at Holy Cross. That was intense! Funerals are a sad part of the life of every parish. They are certain and yet unpredictable: while you know that they *will* happen, you don't know too far in advance *when* they will be or for whom. Sometimes you get streaks where you have several in a short span; other times you can go for a while without one. It'd be really nice if the Angel of Death were more consistent and regular when he goes out to do his job, but that's not how it works—and I for one don't want to try to meet him in order to lodge a complaint!

The funeral rites are an important work of mercy. As a Church we pray for the repose of the soul of the deceased and find comfort and hope in our communal worship of God in difficult times. I am very grateful to the staff and volunteers of the parish who help plan and celebrate these important Masses. A lot of moving parts have to come together in a short period of time to make it all happen, and thankfully, it does!

Having said that, there is an area where we need some help. We need a few adults to assist as altar servers for funeral Masses. Having servers at the Masses not only adds to the beauty of the celebration, but it's very helpful on a practical level too. Ideally, we'd have a crew of people we can call on in rotation to help as funerals get scheduled.

I'm sure some people reading this are saying "I'd be happy to help, but I don't have the first clue what I'd be doing" or "I'd love to do it, but having to carry that whole incense thing scares the heck out of me." That's okay. We'll train you. And the incense stuff isn't really scary once you get the hang of it. I promise.

So, if you're someone who generally is available during the week or on Saturdays between 10 and noon and you would be interested in helping in this important work of mercy, please give the office a call and let us know. You would be helping us give a fitting final celebration to our deceased parishioners.

This Saturday, 36 of our parish children will be celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the First Time. Please pray for them as they prepare for this experience of God's mercy in their lives, and continue to pray for them as they continue to prepare to receive their First Holy Communion in May.

Also, one month from today, we will welcome Bishop Senior to Holy Cross Church to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. That will take place at the 11:00 Mass on Sunday, March 6. Please pray for our seventh-graders who are preparing for this beautiful sacrament.
