FROM THE PASTOR

With the recent death of Pope Benedict XVI, all parishes were asked to schedule a public Mass to thank God for his service to the Church and to pray for the repose of his soul. We have scheduled a Mass on the one-month anniversary of his death. Please join us at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, January 31 for this special Mass.

Our Adult Faith Formation and Evangelization Committee will be starting a new **Bible Study** series shortly. The topic will be the letter of St. Paul to the Philippians. It's one of Paul's midsize epistles, written to the community of Philippi during his imprisonment to thank the community for its support, to encourage their faith, and to warn them against errors. Contained in the letter is the text of what is suggested to be one of the earliest hymns about Christ. The group will have Monday evening and Wednesday morning sessions. I'm sure it will be an enjoyable and informative experience.

This weekend, the Office for Catechetical Formation celebrated their annual Mass for Religious Education, an opportunity for all those involved in parish religious education programs to come together in prayer. At the celebration, service awards were presented for those marking special anniversaries. Kelly Meliti, our Director of Religious Education, was recognized for her ten years of service to Holy Cross Parish. Congratulations, Kelly!

We've entered the time where we start compiling our various parish statistics for the prior year: baptisms, funerals, sick calls, demographics of parish families, and more. It's also the time where we start to look at the parish and school budgets for the upcoming fiscal year. There's a lot of data swirling around the office that helps paint the picture of our parish. I've been encouraged by what seems like a recent uptick in the number of people coming to Mass on Sunday, as well as an uptick in the number of people coming to Mass during the week. I've also noticed an uptick in people coming to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance. Our Christmas collection this year was a little larger than it was last year. Those are all hopeful signs. 
