# FROM THE PASTOR

This week, some follow-up items from previous bulletin columns about the goings-on at the parish over the summer.

First, Fr. Collins will be moving in and taking up residence in the rectory this week. I'm sure you'll be seeing him around the parish soon enough. I'll be going on vacation with my family in two weeks, and Father has kindly agreed to cover the Masses and confessions while I'm away.

We've been doing quite a bit of work to prepare his rooms in the rectory—cleaning the carpets, replacing damaged or worn-out furniture, addressing plumbing problems, replacing broken and discolored blinds, etc. We had some helpful high school students from the area volunteer to do a good bit of that work this week, and they did a great job.

Elsewhere on campus, the parish center has gotten a thorough refresh over the past few weeks, thanks to some generous parishioners donating some paint and a lot of sweat equity. A team of volunteers from our Bible Study group gave the paneling a good scrubbing and painted the walls. A beautiful new backdrop for the large wall crucifix was fashioned to replace the dingy burlap that had hung there, and a lot of the dated and worn-out décor and furnishings found a new home in the back of a Springfield trash truck. A few men of the parish have worked on cleaning and polishing the floors as well on both of floors—another project that was long overdue. They were able to do that in part because someone donated a floor scrubbing machine to the school, which got carried over to the parish center for the job.

By a stroke of Divine Providence, we found a few dozen matching chairs in a thrift store to replace the hodge-podge of old, bulky, and stained chairs that had been in there for way too long. A parishioner was kind enough to donate the funds needed for us to buy and transport them, and they were delivered this past week. Once everything is done, it's going to look much nicer in there, which is really exciting. Shameless plug: if you want to see the improvements that were made, feel free to join the next Bible Study when they resume in the Fall.

The school is also getting a very intense deep cleaning this summer. We've brought in an outside company, and they've been working very hard in these extraordinary heat waves. I've gone over a few times, and wow can you see the difference. Floors that looked dingy and worn are bright and shiny again. As the plethora of back-to-school sales in the stores remind us, it's only about six weeks until the kids are back in the classrooms, and I think our students and faculty will be very happy to see how fresh their rooms look.

As you can see, there's a lot going on, and much of it is happening because dedicated parishioners are stepping up to make it happen. We can all be grateful that they are!

## CAN YOU NOT SPEND 1 HOUR WITH ME??



The Eucharistic miracles Lanciano in Italy occurred in the 8th century. A certain priest developed doubts about Christ's presence in Eucharist. One day after consecration, during Mass, the wine and bread visibly turned into blood and flesh. This was preserved through the centuries. In 1970-71 and in 1981, scientist Odoardo Linoli, a professor of pathological histology, clinical microscopy and chemistry as well as anatomy, investigated the miracle.

The professor came to the conclusion that the flesh was cardiac tissue containing veins, nerve fibers and arterioles. The blood type matched with the blood type of other Eucharistic miracles, namely AB. The WHO too verified the finding of the Italian doctors, and after 500 examinations expressed the inability of science to explain Eucharistic miracles Lanciano.
