Baptisms are celebrated the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 PM.



Here we go again. On Monday evening, I received several e-mails from parishioners who had received a text message saying that I needed them to do me a favor and buy a bunch of gift cards for our adopt-a-family program and send the numbers off the cards to them. Oh, and do it all quickly and via text because I was going into an important meeting and time was of the essence. *Very* suspicious. And very fake. **It was definitely a scam**. A couple days ago, the parish office e-mail received a message claiming to be from a priest in the area. It was vague and asked that we contact him. Fortunately, I knew Father, and I knew that the return address wasn't his address. The same day, an email arrived to the parish office claiming to be from me with the exact same message. The return address wasn't mine, but it was awfully close. Both messages were marked as spam and deleted, and the addresses were reported to the e-mail carrier. **Another scam**.

Sadly, the scam artists continue their work of trying to bilk money out of people. They are getting trickier, and it's getting harder to tell what's real and what's a scam. Church members are easy targets. They figure that you're goodhearted people that want to respond charitably to people who have a crisis, and so you become targets. It's disgusting. But it's happening more and more.

The best thing for us to do is be aware that these scams are out there and to be alert to anything that seems even remotely suspicious. Nobody from the parish or the school will ever send you a text message or e-mail asking you to buy a bunch of gift cards and send us the numbers off of them. If something seems fishy, please call or e-mail the office (using numbers/addresses you know are valid) to verify what's going on. If in doubt, ignore the message. You are kind and charitable people; we want that kindness and charity to benefit the Church and the people who need it—not some con artist or thief.

Okay, enough of that. Please note the following change to the parish office hours for the months of July and August. The office will be open Monday – Thursday from 9:00 – 12:00 and 1:00 – 4:00. The office will be closed on Fridays, along with holidays and holy days. A reduced schedule allows our staff a little more flexibility to enjoy a long weekend or plan a vacation without affecting operations at a time we have fewer visitors and phone calls anyway. As always, if you have an emergency while the office is closed, please call the office phone number and follow the prompt. We'll get back to you as quickly as possible.

On the subject of the office and staff, I want to thank Stella De Los Santos for her years of service to Holy Cross as the bookkeeper. Stella is moving on, and we wish her all the best.

Monday is Independence Day! There will be Mass at 8:30 am as we celebrate the birth of our nation and pray for God's continued blessings upon us. (And yes, the office will be closed for the holiday.)
