

Happy Father's Day to all the dads!

Due to an early bulletin deadline, I'm writing this column a week early, but if all goes as planned, the Father's Day remembrance tree should be up and on display in the church this weekend. A big **thank you** to the members of the choir who spent a lot of time making the ribbons and decorating both the Mother's Day and Father's Day trees. Impressive work!

Two weeks ago, I wrote a pretty long column about our **heating and air conditioning system** and its challenges. The engineer visited a second time for a more in-depth look at the controls to see why the current A/C is so temperamental and doesn't turn on or stay on. Armed with that information, and knowing our financial situation right now, he's going to see what we can come up with. In the meantime, we keep our fingers crossed as we try to get the system to work.

I've mentioned **scrip** here a few times, and I'm going to keep mentioning it in the hopes of continuing to drum up support of this important fundraising initiative for the school. So far since we launched the program, we've generated about \$600 in revenue for the school. We can do better. The bulk of that revenue came from just one person, who used scrip just for her regular grocery shopping. Not too many other people have made much use of the program. Now imagine the impact we could have if 10 families, or 50 families, or 100 families would use scrip just for their groceries. The staff and I will be working with the principal and Home and School to find ways to promote scrip among school families, but **the whole parish can help**. The more money we raise for the school, the lower our parish subsidy, which means the more we can spend on pastoral programs and facility repairs and upgrades. If you're someone who gives gift cards for birthdays, etc., consider buying them through the scrip program. No additional cost to you, and you help us provide tuition assistance to our school students.

Finally this week, an update on **Deacon Bob Frankenberger**. As some of you know, Deacon Bob was involved in a car accident on church grounds about a month ago. His car and our rock wall were damaged pretty heavily, but thankfully nobody suffered any injuries! However, the accident did inspire some conversation and decision-making. In light of his age (almost 96!) and some of the increasing mobility challenges he's been having, Deacon Bob and his family have decided it would be best for him to live in a facility where he will have access to some additional care and help if and when needed. Out of respect for his privacy, we're not able to give much more information, and we appreciate your understanding of that. I know that for him, not being at Holy Cross every day is going to be a major adjustment. Deacon Bob loves this parish and the people, and he has dedicated so much of his life to caring for his fellow parishioners. Now it's time for others to care for him. Please keep him in your prayers. If you would like to write a note or send a card to Deacon Bob, you can send it to the parish office, and we will make sure it gets to him.
