

Happy Pentecost! May the gifts of the Holy Spirit be amplified in each one of us so that we can bear good fruit as workers in the Kingdom.

It's the first weekend of June, and already this year we've had multiple days with temperatures well into the 90's. I hope that's not an omen for what is to come this Summer, especially since we've been told to expect higher utility rates in the months ahead.

Now that we've reached the point where it's time to run the air conditioning, it's a good time to give a reminder and an update on where we are with our heating and air conditioning improvement projects for the church. As I mentioned before, there are multiple problems to address. Problem 1: temperature regulation. The pneumatic thermostat system in the church has not worked for many years and at this point is beyond repair. That means that we have to manually turn the air conditioning on and off, and if it's on, it's on full blast. Well, it should be, except for.... Problem 2: the controller for the air conditioner does not work properly. We can turn the controller on, but that doesn't mean it will actually turn on the cooling tower and engage the compressors—nor does it mean that they will actually stay on. Some days, you turn it on, and everything starts humming beautifully. Others, it may take fifteen minutes until you get cold air blowing. And on other days, it may be an hour and you get nothing. It's a roll of the dice, and I'm starting to think that like most forms of gambling, the odds are against us!

Last year, we got to a point where it was on and seemingly stable, and we were advised not to turn it off. It ran 24/7 for most of the Summer. You don't want to know how expensive the bills for electricity and water were as a result! We can't do that again this year. It was way too expensive, and way too uncomfortable in the church. For now, we're going to monitor the weather forecast and make decisions about turning it on based on the expected temperatures and what is happening in the church, while praying that the system will actually work when we need it to. So far this year, we've had some good days, and we've had a couple days where we tried every trick we know and it still wouldn't produce cold air. If you see John Kemmey or Ron Gardner, be sure to thank them for all the extra effort they have putting in to wrestle with the cooling system. They both deserve to go straight to heaven for all the hassle!

We are looking into a bid to get a new control system in place, but I will have to discuss with the finance council to see if we can afford and how we would pay for further improvements, especially since we spent so much of our financial reserve on replacing the boiler and some of the plumbing around it. Your support in using the Tame Our Temp envelopes is one way we can help pay for all this. So far, the various heating and air conditioning projects have cost around \$80,000. We've raised about \$10,000 through this special envelope campaign. Your generosity is appreciated. We've had several parish families make multiple contributions, and I am grateful.
