Baptisms are celebrated the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 PM.



The other day I was looking for some information that I thought was sent to me in an e-mail two or three weeks ago. I kept looking and couldn't find it, until I scrolled down further and realized the message actually arrived at the end of February! I don't know about you, but I find it hard to believe that it's the beginning of May already.

May is a beautiful month. Next week is Mother's Day. Colleges begin to wind down their semesters and prepare for graduations. In a few weeks, the Archdiocese will be ordaining new deacons and priests to serve the Church, and priests will be celebrating the anniversaries of their ordinations. The Ascension usually happens during May, and of course at the end of the month we have a day dedicated to the memory of those who died in service to our nation on Memorial Day.

More locally, this Saturday, May 7, at 10:00 am, a number of our parish children will receive Holy Communion for the first time. Please keep them in your prayers as they celebrate this beautiful occasion. I'm sure they are very excited for this moment, and their teachers and catechists have been working hard all year to prepare them, for which we are grateful as a parish.

One other calendar item: all the priests of the Archdiocese will be gathering for a workshop in Hershey next week from Monday – Wednesday. It is an opportunity for us to pray together and to discuss things that are going in the Archdiocese. We usually have a workshop every Spring, but the Covid pandemic cancelled the last couple. Because of the workshop, we have to modify our Mass schedule for next week. There WILL be Mass on Monday, May 9 at 8:30 am. On Tuesday and Wednesday, there will be a Communion Service. (Thank you, Deacon Bob, for helping with that!) Things go back to normal on Thursday. Please pray for me and my brother priests while we're away that our prayer and discussions together will help us better serve you.

The reality that Summer is around the corner means it's time for a bit of a Help Wanted note. We are very blessed by the number of parishioners who volunteer in our various liturgical ministries (lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, altar servers, choir members). We are, however, looking to add a few more people to their number. Over the past couple years, some of our ministers have stepped down or have been unable to serve for health reasons, and with vacations and frequent trips to the shore, it's harder to fill all the needs in the Summer months. So, if you're at all interested in reading at Mass, or you'd like to be considered to be appointed to help distribute Holy Communion, or if you know a child (4th grade and up) who'd be willing to serve at the altar, please call the parish office and let us know. Oh, adults are also needed who can help serve funerals, especially on weekday mornings. Once we know who is interested, we can work on scheduling the necessary training and get them on board. If you're not entirely sure, there's no harm in saying you're interested now and then making a decision after you've had more time to think it over.


