Your parish misses you!

Oftentimes in the Church when we hear the word "shepherd," we think of our bishops and priests and the shepherding that they are called to do. Jesus is indeed the Good Shepherd Who cares for His sheep - and those called to Holy Orders are called to imitate Him. There is a rather brief article this month in the Magnificat Magazine that I usually have with me at Mass. This article made me call to mind someone that I hadn't thought of for a while; someone that was a classmate; someone that was ordained as priest and shepherd just three hours before his death. I only knew him briefly, but he made quite the impact. He was kind and welcoming and in retrospect, I would say that he had an air of holiness about him. Gene Hamilton was one of the seminarians from the Archdiocese of New York that joined together with the Philadelphia seminarians in the fall of 1995 on what was called the Spirituality Year. The location was beautiful Mary Immaculate Seminary just north of Allentown. It was quite the year for all of us. Unfortunately, Gene was only able to be with us for a short time. His cancer diagnosis and treatment required him to be at home. I remember speaking with his father (a permanent deacon) and his mother when they came to retrieve his belongings from the seminary. I assured them of my prayers for which they were grateful. We were all praying for Gene. The miracle for Gene was not that he would win his battle over cancer, but that he would indeed be ordained a priest by special permission on his deathbed. I remember that his ordination, in fact, raised some eyebrows. He was near death, so what would be the point? However, the permission given by the Holy Father speaks to the nature of the priesthood. It is a shepherding that only begins in this life, but continues in some mysterious way in the next. Jesus was the Good Shepherd – and thankfully, He is still the Good Shepherd guarding, watching, protecting, and caring for His flock. In his very brief time as a priest on this earth, Fr. Gene was able to offer his priestly benediction by tracing ever so lightly the Sign of the Cross on the hand of those nearby. Even the Hindu doctor treating him was moved and noticed that same air of holiness. Fr. Gene listed five traits as central to his priesthood: servant, victim, brother, listener, and friend. He was and he is for me a model of what it means to be a shepherd and what it means to follow in the footsteps of Jesus, the Good Shepherd. Now, I hope that he can be a model, a friend, and an intercessor for you.

Remember: Pray for the sick and those that have died. Pray for a containment of the virus. Pray for a vaccine. Turn especially to Our Lady. We know that the Lord can hardly turn down a request made by His Mother – especially on Mother's Day!

Our Lady of the Holy Cross! Pray for us!

Do you or your company pay PA state taxes?

Individuals

Individuals can redirect up to 100% of their personal Pennsylvania state income tax bill to Holy Cross. Donors will receive a tax credit for 90% of the EITC or OSTC contribution, which reduces their state income taxes dollar-for-dollar. Further, many individuals will also be able to claim a charitable deduction on their federal tax return for the 10% not included in the tax credit.

Corporations

Corporations are also eligible to receive a 90% Pennsylvania tax credit if they are authorized to do business in Pennsylvania and are subject to one or more of the following taxes:

- Corporate Net Income Tax
- Insurance Premium Tax (excluding surplus lines, unauthorized, domestic/foreign

marine)

- Title Insurance & Trust Company Shares Tax
- Bank and Trust Company Shares Tax
- Capital Stock and Franchise Tax
- Mutual Thrift Tax
- Malt Beverage Tax
- Retaliatory Fees under section 212 of the Insurance Company Law of 1921
- Personal Income Tax of corporation shareholders or Partnership partners
