FROM THE PASTOR

We are three weeks away from our Second Annual Welcome Summer Family Fun Day! Plan to join us for free food and fun on Sunday, June 2, after the 11:00 Mass. We'll have a DJ, bounce houses, some yard games and face painting. Last year, we had a great turnout of parishioners of all ages, and we want an even better turnout this year! Start praying for good weather now as well. An RSVP would be very helpful, so we know how much food to prepare. You can contact the office, or you can scan the QR code on our promotional materials. (Yes, we are trying to do some things the 21st century way around here...)

To make this event a success, we're looking once again for sponsors and patrons to help underwrite some of the costs. Sponsorships are available for the whole event, or for specific aspects (food & drink, DJ, bounce houses). Different levels of support as a patron are also available. Forms are available in the church vestibules.

Some good news to share: a few months ago, we applied for a safety grant for the school from the PA Department of Education. The grant was written to add additional security cameras in and around the school building. We recently found out that we were selected as a grant recipient and expect an award of \$25,000. We're now in the process of submitting the final quote so we can get the funds released for us. I'm hoping (with perhaps a lot of cautious optimism) that we can get the final approvals and get the work scheduled for over the summer months. I do want to thank Daniel Salvatore and Terry Carey for all their work in getting the grant and Ron Gardner for working with an outside vendor to get the quote finalized quickly. (The process is a lot of hurry up and wait. You have a small window to apply; it takes months to hear from them; and when you do, you only have like a week to get a detailed quote and get it back to them. Then you wait until they decide to review it and release the funds.)

Next Sunday is Pentecost! In many places it's become customary for everyone to wear red for the Holy Spirit when they go to Mass on Pentecost. So if you remember, wear red next Sunday.

Finally, Happy Mother's Day to all the moms out there!






