# FROM THE PASTOR

Happy Memorial Day! I've said it before, and I think it's worth repeating: Memorial Day is in many ways a secular version of All Souls' Day. It's an opportunity for us to remember the dead who died protecting our nation in military service. Parades and barbecues are great. But the best way for us as Catholics to honor and remember the fallen is by our prayer for them. And there is no higher form of prayer than the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. **Please join us Monday morning at 8:30 as we offer Mass for all those who died in service to our nation.**

This time in May marks the anniversary of ordination for many priests in the Archdiocese. I find it hard to believe that I was ordained a priest ten years ago on May 16. This past week, Fr. Collins marked 53 years of faithful service as a priest. We are blessed as a parish that in his retirement, Father continues that faithful service here at Holy Cross—assisting with Mass, hearing confessions, providing a wealth of information on all matters historical, and even making us groan from time to time with some really good (or bad, depending on your perspective) puns. Thank you, Father, for all you do here.

Last Saturday, five men were ordained to serve the Archdiocese as priests. It was also announced that six priests were retiring this year—one of whom is our former pastor Fr. Gabin. Many other priests are staying on in their parishes for several years past their retirement age. Please pray for our new priests, and continue to pray fervently for an increase in vocations to the priesthood.

We are two weeks away from our third annual **Summer Family Fun Day!** The fun happens on **Sunday, June 8 from 12-3**, rain or shine. (If the weather looks bad, we'll have everything in the gym. But you're all going to ask God to send us good weather for that day, right?) Once again, we'll have **free food**, a DJ, bounce houses, face painting, games, and more. This is a great opportunity for outreach to our less-than-active community: invite your friends, family, and neighbors to come have fun!

**This Thursday is Ascension Thursday!** For those of us who live in Pennsylvania, it is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses are at 8:30am and 7:00pm.

## May 26, 2025, Memorial Day

The Springfield American Legion Post 227 and Springfield Township, Delaware County again hosts Memorial Day parade and services, remembering all Springfield residents who made the ultimate sacrifice in the defense of our country and our community.

Please Note: There is a change in location and parade route from previous years.

9:15 AM A brief Memorial Service will start in front of St. Francis Church World War II Memorial, 136 Saxer Avenue, Springfield, PA 19064, followed by a parade on Saxer Avenue and Powell Road to Old Central School  
10:00 AM Memorial Service at Old Central School

This year we will be honoring and remembering United States Army 2nd Lt. Donald S. Weightman, a 1937 graduate of Springfield High School and Springfield resident who was a co-pilot of a B-17 Flying Fortress when on a bombing mission on February 10, 1944, the aircraft was heavily damaged and presumed lost in the North Sea attempting to return to their base in England. The aircraft and crew were never seen nor heard from again.

At the time of his passing he had wife and one month old son. That son is now 81 years old and living in Ohio. He plans to travel to Springfield to attend the Memorial Day Service honoring his father.

A Springfield Hero banner is on Woodland Avenue (Route 420) in front of E.T. Richardson Middle School honoring his memory.

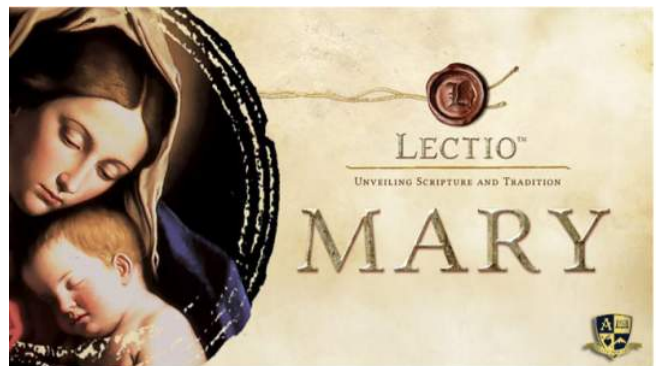
