Baptisms are celebrated the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month at 12:00 PM.



First, of course, I have to say Happy **Mother's Day** to all the mothers out there (and especially to my own, since I know she likes to read our bulletin each week. Hi Mom!)

A quick reminder about a slight change to the Mass schedule this week. Because the priests of the Archdiocese will be away for a workshop, we are unable to have Mass on Tuesday or Wednesday. We will have Communion Services those days, thanks to the generosity of Deacon Bob. There will be a Mass at 8:30 Monday morning.

Good news: On Easter Sunday, we began our **Tame our Temp** envelope campaign to help raise money to replenish our savings after paying for the new boiler and some other repairs to our heating and air conditioning system. In the first two weeks, we already raised just shy of \$4,000. That's wonderful, and I thank everyone who helped contribute so far. That being said, the amount the parish spent so far on the different projects is about 20 times that figure, so we're probably going to keep those envelopes out for a while. Your continued generosity with this is needed and appreciated.

Over the past month or two, the staff and I have been taking a look at the parish and school budgets and preparing for next year. Not exactly high on my list of 'amazing things you get to do as a priest,' but something we have to do none-theless. The Finance Council met recently for some discussion about where things are and where we're going financially. One thing we decided is that in the near future we're going to start running a more thorough financial snapshot in the bulletin each week.

In the past, we have simply printed the weekly collection total. The challenge with that approach is that income numbers don't mean much unless you can compare them to expenses for context. So, we want to start providing a summary of some of our bills and expenses to give you a better picture of where we are as a parish and how we use the money that you give us in support of our mission and operations. We're still fine-tuning what this report will look like, but once it starts to appear, I ask you to please take a look at it regularly.

There's much more that can be said about our parish finances, and I'll be devoting some space in the bulletin over the next few weeks to provide more information as we soon come to the close of the fiscal year. I'll say this now though: I don't want the reputation of being the priest who only talks about money. There's a lot of other things I'd rather talk about. But we have to care for these big, beautiful buildings that were built by prior generations for the worship of God and for religious formation, and we have to pay our bills. I think transparency is important, and that's the goal with all these discussions.

Enough of that, let's move back to something spiritual. Prayerful congratulations to our children who received Holy Communion for the first time on Saturday! They were invited to wear their special Communion outfits again to the Mass they attend for Sunday, so if you see some kids all dressed up, please congratulate them.
