# FROM THE PASTOR

Last weekend's site visit from Catholic Leadership Institute as part of the Next Generation Parish program went very well. It will take several weeks for the consultant to write up the full report with her observations at our Masses and the fruits of the discussions she had with some of our parishioners and staff. I will be away at a two-day workshop this week to discuss this program and some of the next steps with representatives from CLI and other priests of the Archdiocese whose parishes are also going through this program for renewal.

I did get some initial comments from the consultant that I'm sure will show up in the report. None of us will be surprised to hear that she said the church was big and beautiful. The stained-glass Resurrection scene behind the sanctuary is impressive. As a parish, we can be proud of the beauty of the space where we gather for worship.

One thing that surprised her was the number of people who arrived well after Mass had started and the number who left before Mass was over. She asked if that was normal, and I sheepishly said yes, it's not an uncommon occurrence. We do seem to have a consistent pattern of late arrivals and early departures. It might be good for each of us to examine if a personal change is needed to remedy that. Sure, everyone is going to have the occasional day of being all set to leave but not being able to find the car keys. And around here lately you never know what local streets are going to be dug up and detoured. But, if we find ourselves habitually late to Mass, we should ask ourselves why that is and try to rectify that. If you plan to arrive early and spend 5-10 minutes in silent recollection and prayer before Mass, I think you'll find it will lead to a more fruitful and prayerful experience.

I want to thank the members of our fundraising committee for their hard work in putting together this weekend's Beef and Beer Dance Party! A lot of work went into planning this event, and a number of volunteers stepped up and did a lot to help make this happen. Events like this help bring our parish community together and show us off a bit to the larger community—especially when you invite your friends and neighbors. As of when I'm writing this, the event looks like it will be a complete success, and that's thanks to the team for planning it and to you for coming to support it!

October is Respect Life month and the month of the Holy Rosary. On Saturday, October 8, a group of parishioners will be praying the Rosary in front of the church building at noon. Please consider joining them in prayer as they pray for our nation.
